

North Side: East 37th Street - Madison to Park



19 East 37th Street- Tax Block/Lot #867/24

Five-story neo-Georgian town house (C.P.H. Gilbert, 1905, for Charles Healy Ditson), stone-faced first story and entrance porch, brick upper stories with bay windows at the second and third story. It replaced a four-story brownstone formerly the residence of Parke Godwin, "well-known writer and editor" (NYT) and son-in-law of poet and *Evening Post* editor William Cullen Bryant. Ditson was a music publisher, and president of the Oliver Ditson Company of Boston and the Charles H. Ditson Company of New York.
