Important Notice

On or about March 25th, The NYCDOT will begin milling and paving sections of Park Avenue as part of the Park Avenue Tunnel Rehabilitation Project. This operation will also require a full tunnel closure for approximately two weeks. Parking lanes will be temporarily removed to accommodate the work zones. Please adhere to the *No Standing Anytime* rules that will be in effect. Temporary lane shifts will be required at the locations listed below.

Park Avenue and 33rd Street

- *NB and SB parking lanes removed*
- *WB 33rd Street temporarily closed between Lexington and Park Avenue*

Park Avenue and 40th Street

- *NB and SB parking lanes removed between 39th and 40th Street*
- *NB Park Avenue - No right turn onto 40th Street*

Milling will begin on or about March 25th for two nights. The resurfacing will follow on or about April 1st for two nights. These activities will be performed between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Traffic Control Agents will be assigned to facilitate the flow of vehicular traffic. **One lane will be open to traffic at all times.**
