Four-story-and basement town house (Francis G. Stewart, 1909-10, for Edward Wright Sheldon), based in limestone and granite, with unusual new-Gothic label lintels. Sheldon became President of the United States Trust Company in 1906; he became Chairman of the Board in 1927. "Although his financial interests were wide-- he had been a director of thirteen insurance companies, a railroad and a real estate corporation besides his banking interests--Mr. Sheldon found time to participate in the management of several major philanthropic, educational and health institutions" (NYT), Source: NB 849-09; NYT 12/24/1999, p. 13, 2/16/1934 p. 19. **Now the Permanent Mission of El Salvador to the United Nations.**
