The New York City Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC) continues to manage the \$37 million dollar capital construction Infrastructure Upgrade Project #MED607. Work includes, but is not limited to, the installation of catch basins at various locations, utility upgrades, limited sewer upgrades, new hydrant installation and the installation of new water main pipes in various locations between 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue. and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. and between East 32<sup>nd</sup> Street and East 36<sup>th</sup> Street

Also, along East 35<sup>th</sup> Street between 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and the QMT Entrance and the QMT Entrance and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. Along East 35<sup>th</sup> Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and the QMT Exit and along East 35<sup>th</sup> Street between the QMT Exit and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue

The city contractor will continue supporting Con Edison utility work along the east side of 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue. between E 34<sup>th</sup> St. and E 36<sup>th</sup> St.

Excavation and installation of water main along East 35<sup>th</sup> Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue.
