DDC Begins Replacement of Water Main Project In Second Ave. & Surrounding Areas

Please be advised that on/about June 18, 2018 The New York City Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC) will begin Project # MED607 for the replacement of water main in the Borough of Manhattan on 2nd Ave. and surrounding areas. The purpose of this project is to improve NYC water main/infrastructure system. This work begins with test water shut downs, tree pruning/installation of tree guards, utility relocation work, saw cutting, digging of test pits which are small, minimal impact excavations to determine what types of infrastructure is below ground before larger trenching occurs. The scope of work includes installation of distribution and trunk water main, replacement of fire hydrants, isolated curb installation, sewer and utility work and final roadway restoration. *Weather and field conditions permitting.*

WHERE WILL WORK BE PERFORMED?

Work will be performed at the following locations:

- 3rd Avenue between East 32nd Street and East 36th Street
- 2nd Avenue between East 32nd Street and East 37th Street
- East 33rd Street between Lexington Avenue and 2nd Avenue
- East 35th Street between Lexington Avenue and 1st Avenue
- East 36th Street between Queens-Midtown Tunnel Exit and Queens-Midtown Tunnel Approach
- Intersection of 1st Avenue and East 35th Street

WHAT ARE THE COMMUNITY IMPACTS?

DDC is committed to maintaining a work site that is safe and clean. However, dust, noise and heavy equipment are common elements of construction and we ask for your patience during the project. In order to facilitate the construction, there may be limited street access on certain blocks. However, deliveries to commercial/residential properties and emergency vehicle access will be allowed. Please contact the Community Construction Liaison to coordinate.

WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTIONS

When a water service interruption is scheduled you will be notified via email and will be hand distributed an official shut down notification

- A 72- hour e-mail notice will be provided throughout the affected shut down area along with instructions on how to prepare for the test water service interruption. A 24-hour confirmation/cancellation will follow and will be distributed/posted to any/all affected location(s).

Pedestrian Access/ Parking

- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Street access/traffic detours are expected and may limit total access to the streets.
- Parking will be temporarily restricted so construction may proceed. Signs will be posted in advance where necessary.
- Access to driveways/loading dock access may be intermittently restricted.
- Deliveries and garbage pickups will be coordinated as needed.

Public Transportation

- Bus stops and/or bus routes may be relocated during the course of construction. Signs and directions will be posted noting the changes in advance.
