# Important Notice

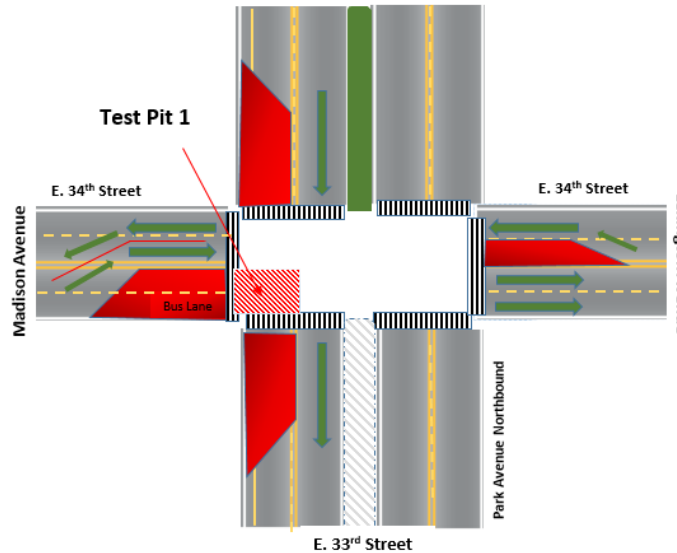
The NYCDOT Division of Bridges will begin the excavation of multiple test pits alongside Park Avenue and 34<sup>th</sup> Street to identify the location of existing water main infrastructure. The work is part of the ongoing Park Avenue Tunnel Rehabilitation Project. Construction will begin on or about Monday, April 27<sup>th</sup> and continue for approximately 2 weeks. Temporary lane closures will be required on Park Avenue northbound and southbound, and on 34<sup>th</sup> Street. *Pedestrian walkways will be installed and Traffic Control Agents will be assigned to facilitate the flow of vehicular traffic.*

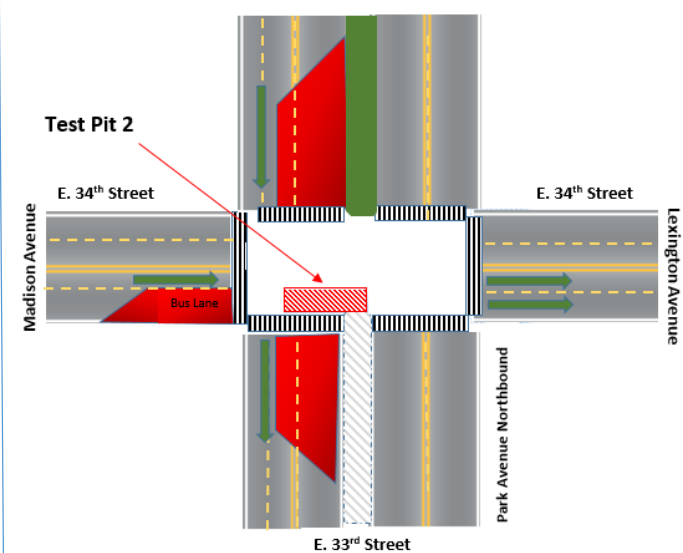
Test Pits 1 and 2

Park Avenue **Southbound** between E. 33<sup>rd</sup> and E. 35<sup>th</sup> Streets

*On or about April 27<sup>th</sup> through May 8<sup>th</sup> - 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. weekdays*



- Southbound **RIGHT** Lane Closed
- Right Parking Lane Parking Removed
- Westbound left lane closure
- Eastbound traffic will be diverted to westbound lane
- One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times



- Southbound **LEFT** Lanes Closed
- Right Parking Lane Parking Removed
- No Standing Anytime
- Eastbound Right Lane on 34<sup>th</sup> Street Closed
- One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times
